Style and geometry, serial motifs and repeated chromatisms denote the production of Artist. His creations - real artistic artifacts result of his tireless personal research carried out inside his atelier - reveal a rhythm in the almost counterpoint composition.


This vibrant soul had its most pregnant key in stylistic constructivism and rigorous geometry, which always insisted on the primacy of its intuitions instead to contemporary taste.
